

# Total Immersion 2017: FYI

**CHECK-IN (Sunday, June 25 at 5:00pm) and CHECK-OUT (Wednesday, June 28 at 10:00am):**

**Where:** Check In will take place at Uplands Reach Conference Center.

**When:** Check-In is at 5:00pm on Sunday, and Check-Out will be at 10:00am on Wednesday. Parents, Guardians, and Group Leaders who accompany Teens should be prepared to stay through the end of the Check-In process.

**Camp Nurse and Lifeguards:** Medical personnel and lifeguards will be on duty at all times. At Check-In, campers must be prepared to discuss any medical information with the Camp Nurse or swimming instructions with the lifeguard. All medications (prescription and non-prescription) **must** be turned in to the Camp Nurse at Check-In.

**PAYMENTS:** All groups and individuals must have their camp fee and Registration Form in our office by **May 19** in order to qualify for the \$50 discount. Encouragers must also complete and mail their **ADULT PARTICIPANT & VOLUNTEER APPLICATION**.

**MEALS:** All meals will be provided beginning with breakfast on Monday and ending with breakfast on Wednesday. Dinner will **NOT be provided** by URCC on Sunday, so make sure campers eat before arriving. **PLEASE NOTE:** For an extra \$25, there will be six spots available each day on Monday and Tuesday for a Cowboy Breakfast and trail ride.

**CELL PHONES:** Once campers arrive at URCC, they will be able to call and let parents and guardians know that they arrived safely. In order to keep the spiritual focus of the camp, all campers must turn in their cell phones. They will be returned during dismissal on Wednesday. We encourage your child to leave his or her cell phone at home. Thanks for helping us keep your teens focused on Christ. If you have a need, call our office at (336) 667-7177. **DEPARTURE:** Parents, please make arrangements to pick up campers at 10:00am on Wednesday. **Please note:** Only people listed on the Registration Form as having permission to pick up your teen will be allowed to do so.

## Uplands Reach Dress Code

We require modest shorts (no shorter than your fingertips) for both guys and girls. Shirts are to be of modest length with no skin showing in the midriff area. Sleeveless shirts are permitted as long as they are modest under the arm. Spaghetti straps, tank tops, and halter tops are not acceptable. For water activities, we ask that guys and girls wear darker clothing. For girls, this means shorts and a dark t-shirt over their swimsuit. For guys, this means swimming trunks and a dark t-shirt. ## Teen Camp Rules

1. This is a NO TOUCHY CAMPY!!
2. Bring your Bible, notebook, and pen to every service.
3. Get involved in your Bible reading and Scripture Memory.
4. Treat everyone with respect.
5. Take care of all URCC property. Groups or individuals are liable for any damage caused during their visit.
6. Follow the camp dress code and dress modestly.
7. Turn your vehicle keys in to your URCC Small Group Leader. Only Staff vehicles area allowed on Bethel Pass.
8. Turn your cell phone in to your URCC Small Group Leader.
9. You are only allowed in your assigned dorm. Never go in your dorm without a URCC Staffer.
10. Do not share a bed.
11. You are responsible for keeping your dorm clean. Every morning dorms must be cleaned, beds made, floors swept, and trash put in the dumpster. Remember that URCC is God's property.
12. Respect the designated lights out time.
13. Pranks are never allowed.
14. Campers are not allowed on or behind the stage.
15. NO TV, magazines, music systems, gaming systems, weapons (including knives), matches, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, or drugs are allowed. All drugs, prescription and non-prescription, must be given to the Camp Nurse.
